#### **The Story Setup: Grandma**

Interesting Character	Female, Roxie, sixties, gun-toting, tractor-driving, horse- riding, tough-as-nails widow rancher. Loves spending time with her little cow girl, ten-year-old granddaughter.
Inciting Incident	Gets a call that neighbor's dog has mauled yet another one of her calves. Goes over to demand dog be put down. Interrupts drug deal punishment with some nasties.
THOM R	Threat. They're coming after her.
Gain\Retain	Life, security. Escape these specific murderers.
Formidable Obstacle	Doesn't have phone, out in a rural area. She's in an old pickup. They're in a new SUV. The granddaughter pops up from backseat, having sneaked in to surprise her.

#### **The Story Setup: Hotdog**

Interesting Character	Female, twenties, Luna, dirt-poor but resourceful, working at hotdog stand, trying to save \$ for college
Inciting Incident	Attractive, teasing cop questions her about a crime that occurred in parking lot. He comes back later sans uniform showing interest.
THOM R	Relationship opportunity, with this specific guy
Gain\Retain	Love, maybe this specific guy?
Formidable Obstacle	She's helping illegals. He's not a cop, he's an ICE agent.

# **The Story Setup: Hotdog 2**

Interesting Character	Female, twenties, Jane, dirt-poor but resourceful, working at hotdog stand, trying to pay \$ for college
Inciting Incident	Attractive, teasing cop questions her about a crime that occurred in parking lot. He comes back later sans uniform showing interest.
THOM R	Relationship opportunity, with this specific guy
Gain\Retain	Love, maybe this specific guy?
Formidable Obstacle	Her brother's into drug distribution, and other things. She's got a record. She's got old ties. Including a criminal boyfriend from the past.

# **The Story Setup: Hotdog 3**

Interesting Character	Female, twenties, Jane, dirt-poor but resourceful, working at hotdog stand, trying to pay \$ for college
Inciting Incident	Her shack gets blown over in a massive wind. Humble guy wearing a cowboy hat helps her out.
THOM R	Relationship opportunity, with this specific cowboy
Gain\Retain	Love, with this specific cowboy
Formidable Obstacle	Wants to escape current class, pursing a life of high finance, New York, big city stuff. Is receiving interest from a rich boy.

# **The Story Setup: Grandma 2**

Interesting Character	Female, Roxie, sixties, smart, put together, but starting to forget things, manages ice cream co-op. Earning to help pay for daughter's cancer treatments.
Inciting Incident	She loses a deposit for \$30,000. Then an investigation shows something not right with books.
THOM R	Threat. Younger gal wants her job, is campaigning to get her out. She's accused of negligence, then intent.
Gain\Retain	Find the lost money. Prove innocence.
Formidable Obstacle	She's only got a week before the board votes. Cops and younger gal are building a case. She knows it was stolen, but there are no leads. Only one that believes her is grumpy Ernie, who she grew up with.

# **The Story Setup: Leap Year**

Interesting Character	Female, twenties, Anna, successful, vivacious real estate stager, helping others envision home of dreams. Wants to be loved. Wants a man who wants her. That home life.
Inciting Incident	Father tells her about leap year tradition. Opportunity. She decides to go.
THOM R	Hardship. Fiancé hasn't proposed in four years, doesn't want to commit.
Gain\Retain	Love. Her specific boyfriend.
Formidable Obstacle	Weather diverts plane, then boat, and she's in the middle of nowhere. Has deadline. Countryside obstacles. Boyfriend doesn't want to marry.
